(U) General Targeting Analyst Positions and Descriptions

■ **(U) USAF Targeting Analysts** – Provide targeting intelligence, develop targeting solutions, and evaluates effects in support of planning and execution of an effects-based approach to operations to achieve commander's objectives.

(U) USAF Targeting Analyst Positions


- (U) Air Operations Center (AOC) Targeting Analyst Provides target discovery, target development, and target system analysis.
- **(U) Unit Level Intelligence (ULI) Targeting Analyst** Provide weapon system specific combat support for the air tasking order (ATO), cyber tasking order (CTO), or joint space tasking order (JSTO) within their Mission Planning Cell (MPC).
- **(U) Federated Reach-back Support** Support Targeting Analysts by providing targeting and geospatial products and services, expertise, and advocacy for USAF and Joint Warfighters.
